

PROF. DR. NOEMI BORDONI, MEMBER OF OUR EDITORIAL BOARD AND ACTIVE COLLABORATOR AS REVIEWER, IS ONE OF THE THREE CANDIDATES FOR THE VICE-PRESIDENCY OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR DENTAL RESEARCH



Dr. Noemi Bordoni PhD is Emeritus Professor and Director of the Institute for Research in Public Health, University of Buenos Aires. Since 2005, she has been a Full Member of the National Academy of Dentistry, Argentina.

In 1963, Dr. Bordoni joined the Argentine Society for Dental Research and she has been a member of the IADR since 1982. She was President of the Argentine Division of the International Association for Dental Research from 2002 to 2003. She has been a member of the committee for the Code of Professional Conduct of the Argentine Division of the IADR. Dr. Bordoni was invited by the School of Dentistry of the University of Buenos Aires in 1979 to create and direct the Department of Preventive and Community Dentistry, where she was Head Professor until 2003. Her commitment to Higher Education and Research has earned her a series of appointments to positions at the University of Buenos Aires and organizations in different countries.

Throughout her extensive career, Dr. Bordoni has been distinguished with numerous honors and awards. The honors she has received include *Senior Researcher IADR/ Latin American Region* (2012), and *Great Master in Dentistry* of the University of Buenos Aires in 2010 (Bi-Centennial of the May Revolution) and 2009 (190th Anniversary of the University of Buenos Aires). She has received over 20 awards and honors. She was invited to take part in the Salzburg Seminar in 2001 (Academic Session # 389), and to collaborate with universities in Mexico, Chile, Brazil, Puerto Rico, as well as a number of other organizations.

She has participated as a member of the Editorial Board or Advisory Committee of different Journals, and as juror on assessment committees for award consideration, research projects, doctoral theses, and university professor appointments.

Dr. Bordoni directed a project funded by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation, entitled "Linking Teaching-Dental care-Research" (1985-1992), and has participated in numerous research projects throughout Latin America (Networks; North-South and Adolescence). In 1995 and 1996 she took part in international technical cooperation projects funded by the World Bank (Agreement AR 1266) and the Inter-American Development Bank (Agreement 516-OC-AR). Since 1980, she has directed or co-directed 27 research grants from the University of Buenos Aires and has served as director, co-director or member of special grants from international agencies, Universities or Health Ministries of different countries.

Dr. Bordoni has long been engaged in research, and her current lines of research focus mainly on "Preventive measures and risk-based programs"; "Quality of oral health care and oral health-related quality of life" and "Higher education".

She is author or editor of 6 books, 18 book chapters and over 150 research papers, technical documents, and systematic reviews, and has participated in over 600 congress lectures/presentations.

Her personal statement includes:

- The promotion of interdisciplinary studies and global or regional multisite research,
- The development and incorporation of social impact indicators for research, and
- The encouragement of research into the process of social construction of knowledge, fostering the development of networks supported by agreements among universities, research centers, government agencies, private enterprises and non-governmental organizations, ensuring an ethical framework.
